In order for scholarship funds to be issued, the student must submit to Orange Blossom Football Classic Association, Inc. proof of enrollment and proof of student status from the registrar's office of the admitting HBCU for the upcoming semester.

# QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible, students must meet the following criteria:

- Submit a completed application (available from school counselor or website).
- Must be graduating high school senior in the South Florida area.
- Must be in good academic standing with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and submit an official transcript at the time of application.



- Must submit proof that applicant has been accepted to an HBCU (candidate will have to provide a copy of the acceptance letter before receiving any scholarship funds).
- Must sealed letters of recommendation from individuals that are familiar with the academic achievements, work performance and community service of the applicant, i.e. a student organization faculty advisor. Family members of the applicant are not suitable references.
- Must submit a typed essay of 500 words or less on the following topic: "The significance of a HBCU education and how it will help me globally impact my community."
- Must score a cumulative score of 80 or better on the application. Complete applications must be postmarked no later than July 9, 2021.

Scholarships will be subject to confirmation that the requirements of enrollment have been met by the admitting HBCU.

# WHAT CAN THE SCHOLARSHIP BE USED FOR?

- The scholarship may be used to pay for tuition, college room and board, books, living expenses and/or other college expense and fees. The award recipient must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in a historically black college or university in the United States that holds accredited higher education status.
- The scholarship is not payable for attendance at service academies, virtual universities or certain institutions limited in their purpose or training. The recipient must be enrolled in a course of study leading to a baccalaureate degree. Funds will be released to the student applicant only.
